Ability to clarify concepts and prepare helpful supplementary material

- Lindsay is one of the best - if not the best - teaching assistant I've had during my time at Columbia. I'm thoroughly convinced that if she wanted to, she could teach an entire lecture on her own. Ability to facilitate small group discussions
